## Black Hills Wild Horse Sanctuary

The Institute's federal tax number is 46-0401462. IRAM owns 11,000 acres of private land dedicated to range preservation and a balanced ecosystem. IRAM's finest gift is **The Black Hills Wild Horse Sanctuary**, whose purpose is to provide not only freedom for unadoptable wild horses but also a research area dedicated to solving the problems of wild horse herd management that will contribute to the well-being of wild horses everywhere. ## WAYS OF GIVING

Every dollar is gratefully accepted. Your gift to IRAM supports its mission and qualifies for a charitable giving tax deduction under federal law.

**There are several ways to help:**

### GIFTS OF CASH

Many supporters of IRAM make a contribution of check or credit card. This method of giving provides immediate help to IRAM and provides you with a charitable contribution in the year of your gift.

### GIFT OF STOCK

A gift of stock is also of immediate value. The security might be sold, reinvested or become a part of IRAM's endowment fund to keep the dream alive in the future.

### GIFTS OF REAL ESTATE

A gift of real estate benefits IRAM and may be tax-wise for the donor. Note that an independent, qualified appraisal of your property is required by the IRS if you wish to claim a deduction.

There are many ways to include IRAM in your estate planning. Among these are:

### BEQUESTS

One of the simplest ways to make a gift is through your will or trust. You can name IRAM as a direct beneficiary of specific assets, of a portion of your estate or a residual amount after payment of other obligations and bequests.

### LIFE INCOME GIFTS

Charitable life income arrangements can allow you to increase your income, receive a charitable income tax deduction, avoid capital gains tax and support IRAM. Two of the frequently used life income gifts are a charitable gift annuity and charitable remainder unitrusts.

### INSURANCE AND RETIREMENT PLANS

You can name IRAM as a beneficiary of a life insurance plan, your individual retirement plan (IRA), Keogh plan, 401(k), 403(b) or other qualified pension plan. IRAM can be named as beneficiary for part or all of the proceeds of these plans.

### LAND ACQUISITION PROJECT

You can designate your contribution to our Land Acquisition project. This allows IRAM to purchase additional land, desperately needed, for more of America's unadoptable wild mustangs.

### ENDOWMENT FUND

Your gift to the Endowment Fund joins donations from other caring supporters of IRAM. These gifts have been invested into long term securities to help provide a yearly interest income to help fund the programs that will provide care for the wild horses, that make their home on the Sanctuary, long into the future.
